Re: Broadway Subway Project - Work is happening at Broadway City Hall

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC), a joint venture partnership between Acciona and Ghella, has been awarded the contract to design and build the Broadway Subway Project. The BSPC team will be in your neighbourhood, beginning the week of December 7, 2020.

The abatement and demolition of the buildings at 400, 450, and 456 West Broadway will be completed through three phases of activities and is scheduled to take place over the next 3.5 months.

Phase One is the removal of hazardous materials at all properties. This work begins on Tuesday, December 8 and will occur weekdays from 7 am to 3 pm and take approximately 10 weeks. We expect this work to have minimal impact on traffic and noise as construction vehicles will be utilizing back lanes where possible. Phase Two will start once hazardous materials are removed from each of the buildings. This phase of work includes the removal of electrical and HVAC systems and demolition of interior walls.

Phase Three is the full demolition of buildings on these properties and we anticipate that this work will begin in the new year depending on the completion of the previous phases. Demolition will include the use of machinery and increased trucking over a short period of time. An updated notification will be sent out before the demolition phase begins.

We will continue to keep you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future so you can plan accordingly. Please note, construction schedules can change on short notice. Updates will be posted to the Project's website, emailed to local registered contacts, and additional notification will be provided where possible.

Broadway Subway Project Corporation is committed to safety and Covid-19 Protocols while construction activities are underway and will be following the latest guidance from the Provincial Health Officer and WorkSafe BC. We know that construction can be disruptive, and the team is working hard to minimize the impacts of our work in your neighbourhood. Thank you in advance for your patience during this work.
