The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) will be in your neighbourhood conducting geotechnical investigatigation to collect information that will inform construction planning and safety measures. During the month of February, work will be moving through the following areas:

- Thorton Street (Great Northern Way to E 1ST Avenue)
- Brunswick St (E 7TH Avenue to toward E 8th Ave)
- Cambie Street (West 8th Avenue to West 10 Avenue)
- Main Street (East 8th Avenue to East 10th Avenue)
- Laurel Street (West 8th Avenue to West 10th Avenue)
- Arbutus Street (West 8th Avenue to West 10th Avenue)
- E Broadway (333 E Broadway to Manitoba Street)
- Alberta Street and West Broadway
- West Broadway (Ash St to Willow Street)
- West Broadway (Spruce Street to Birch Street)
- West Broadway (Hemlock Street to Granville Street)
- West Broadway (Fir Street to Cypress Street)

- Access to roads and properties will be maintained.
- Temporary lane closures in some areas.
