





CCTV surveys of sewers near the future Arbutus Station

September 1, 2021

UPDATE: The notification dated June 18, 2021, has been updated with current scheduling details and map location.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) will be in your neighbourhood to document the condition of the sanitary sewer and storm lines near the future Arbutus Station with closed-circuit TV (CCTV) cameras. Work areas include, but are not limited to:

- (Completed) Multiple locations westbound on W Broadway between Burrard and Cypress Streets;
- (Completed) Westbound on W Broadway between Maple and Arbutus Street;
- (Completed) Westbound on W Broadway from the gas station west of Arbutus Street west to the bus stop; and
- Northbound on Cypress Street south of W. Broadway.

There are traffic impacts we want you to be aware of before you travel.

Traffic During Work

- There will be temporary lane closures lasting up to 60 minutes
- Cypress Street: Northbound lane closed south of W Broadway toward the lane. Local traffic only – please watch for signage and flaggers.
- Traffic controllers will be used to direct traffic and assist pedestrians and cyclists.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Access for businesses and residences will be maintained.
- Access to bus stops will be maintained.
- Access to the Shaw Mobi shared bike rack on Cypress Street will be maintained.
- Street parking on Cypress Street will be temporarily restricted during the work.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. We will continue to keep you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future to help you plan accordingly. Thank you in advance for your patience.
