





## Update: Northern intersection of W. Broadway at Yukon Street closed to vehicle traffic into the new year

November 24, 2021

The notification dated October 13, 2021, has been updated with current scheduling details.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building an at-grade, safe and consistent four-lane traffic deck. BSPC is currently relocating utilities running through the northern intersection of Yukon Street at W Broadway, and will soon be excavating for the traffic deck across the intersection.

The northern half of the intersection will continue to be closed to vehicle traffic into the new year with access maintained for cyclists and pedestrians. Yukon Street also continues to be limited to local vehicle traffic only between W 8th Avenue and W. Broadway. The closure is identified by the yellow boxes in the map below; the local-traffic-only area is identified in blue.

People travelling in the area may experience some congestion, and reduced street parking, speed limits and travel lanes. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

Please note, this information is current at the time of sending, however due to unforeseen circumstances, schedules are subject to change.
