





# Traffic deck excavation continues in Mount Pleasant – Broadway reduced to two lanes during daytime off-peak periods

October 22, 2021

## UPDATE: The notification dated September 3, 2021, has been updated with current scheduling details and traffic impact.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building an at-grade, safe and consistent four-lane traffic deck. Construction is moving into the next phase on the north side of E. Broadway between Main and Quebec streets. Since August 5, noisy daytime work continues in preparation for the installation of traffic deck. This work involves removing the road surface, excavating approximately four metres deep, and drilling for structural supports.

People travelling in the area should expect congestion, and reduced street parking, speed limits and travel lanes. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Check out our Project video for more details on how we are building the traffic deck. The shaded area on map below illustrates the area of work.

Please note, this information is current at the time of sending, however due to unforeseen circumstances, schedules are subject to change.













## What to Expect



### **Timing**

 Construction of the traffic deck is underway and anticipated to be completed by the end of the year.



#### Hours of Work\*

- Monday to Saturday
  - o Day: 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- \* Work will primarily be completed Monday to Saturday but may on occasion occur Sunday.



#### Traffic

- Traffic on E. Broadway reduced to one lane in each direction between Main and Quebec streets from 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. Monday-Saturday, starting October 25 and continuing through mid-November.
- Traffic on E. Broadway will be maintained (2 eastbound and 1 westbound) during peak hours.
- The intersection on the north side of E. Broadway at Quebec Street is closed to vehicle traffic, but remains open to pedestrians and cyclists.
- Quebec Street north of E.
  Broadway is restricted to local traffic only.
- Quebec Street south of E.
  Broadway to the lane is closed to vehicle traffic, but remains open to pedestrians and cyclists.
- Turn restrictions in effect at the intersections of E. Broadway at Main Street and Quebec Street.
- Flaggers and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists.



## Impacts/Interruptions

- Residents and businesses may experience noise and vibration.
- No street parking on Broadway from Main Street to Cambie Street.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.
- Pedestrians may be detoured around work zones.
- Transit users can check the <u>Trip Planner</u> as some stop locations have changed.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. Thank you in advance for your patience.
