





Lane shift near future Oak-VGH Station - Night work on Dec. 13, 2021

Note: The notice from December 10, 2021 included this work and we now have current scheduling details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood preparing for traffic deck installation near the future Oak-VGH Station. Work happening between Laurel and Oak streets includes the expansion of existing work zone on north side of Broadway and creation of a dedicated lane for west bound traffic to turn left at Oak intersection.

What to Expect

Throughout major construction activities, access to residences, businesses, and parking lots will be maintained. This work may also result in elevated noise. Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisest construction activities during the early evening and white noise back-up beepers on heavy construction equipment during night construction.

We thank residents for their patience while we conduct the necessary night work. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. The map below shows the area of work. Please note, this information is current at the time of sending; however, schedules are subject to change. BSPC will update the website with specific dates once timelines are confirmed.
