





UPDATE: Night Work: Geotechnical survey near Canada Line Station on Cambie Street at W Broadway continues December 16


Note: The notification dated December 6 has been updated with current scheduling details.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the Broadway Subway Project. In preparation for building a new station connection to the existing Broadway-City Hall station, BSPC will be doing geotechnical surveys near the Canada Line station at Cambie Street and W Broadway on December 16, from 8:30 p.m. to 12 a.m. During this work, traffic on Cambie Street will be reduced to three lanes (2 lanes south and 1 north) between W 8th and W 10th avenues. Traffic on W Broadway will also be reduced to three lanes (2 lanes east and 1 west) through the intersection at Cambie Street.

Please note, this information is current at the time of sending; however, schedules are subject to change. Visit www.broadwaysubway.ca for current details.

What to Expect

People in the area can expect lane closures on both Cambie Street and W Broadway, and a pedestrian detour around the work zone at the northeast corner of Cambie Street at W Broadway. Residents will experience elevated noise during the work. Mitigation measures include, but are not limited, conducting the noisiest construction activities in the early evening, and installing white noise back-up beepers on heavy construction equipment where possible. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
