





Construction Update: Broadway – City Hall Station

February 4, 2022

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood continuing major construction near the future Broadway City Hall Station. Activities for the next three months include:

- **February:** Continuing to relocate sewer lines beneath Cambie Street between W. 10th and W. 8th avenues; relocating utilities along W. Broadway between Alberta and Cambie streets; continuing the excavation of the station head house; and beginning the installation of the traffic deck on the north side of W. Broadway.
- March: Completing the installation of the north side of the traffic deck; and beginning excavation for the traffic deck on the south side of W. Broadway.
- April: Completing the installation of the traffic deck on the south side of W. Broadway; and beginning excavation under the traffic deck for the underground station.

Residents and businesses will experience noise and vibration during major construction activities. People in the area should expect congestion, sidewalk modifications, possible temporary street closures including Yukon Street, temporary lane closures, and reduced street parking, speed limits and travel lanes. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. All businesses remain open and access to residences, businesses and parking lots will be maintained for all abilities. Visit the parking alternatives map for options.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. We will continue to keep you informed in advance of work, including night work for utilities and traffic deck installation, to help you plan accordingly. Thank you for your patience.
