





Construction Update: Great Northern Way – Emily Carr Station and the Elevated Guideway



The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood continuing major construction near the future Great Northern Way – Emily Carr Station. Activities over the next three months include:

- **February:** Continuing bulk excavation; completing water line relocation along Earl Finning Way; completing the relocation of utilities on Carolina Street and E. 1st Ave; beginning the installation of the elevated guideway columns; and conducting geotechnical surveys.
- March April: Continuing the construction of the elevated guideway columns; commencing station concrete work; and managing the arrival and assembly of the first tunnel boring machine.

Residents and businesses will experience noise and vibration during the excavation and installation of the elevated guideway and future station. On December 23 we provided advance notice that core working hours would be extended to 24 hours, as we prepare for tunneling operations this spring. These hours will continue until the tunnel boring is complete. People in the area should expect congestion, sidewalk modifications, possible temporary road closures, temporary lane closures, and reduced street parking and speed limits. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. All businesses remain open and access to residences, businesses and parking lots will be maintained for all abilities.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. We will continue to keep you informed in advance of work to help you plan accordingly. Thank you for your patience.
