





## Vehicle access to the south side of Maple Street from W. Broadway will be temporarily restricted for up to one month starting Thursday January 20

## January 18th, 2022

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood relocating utilities and building the traffic deck on W. Broadway. Beginning on Thursday, January 20, vehicle access to the south side of Maple St. from W. Broadway will be restricted for about one month while work takes place at this intersection.

## What to Expect

While access to the south side of Maple St. is restricted, left turns at Cypress St. will be allowed from W. Broadway, westbound. Road access to Maple St. from 10th Ave to the laneway, parking garages, residences, and businesses will be maintained (see alternative access map for details). Pedestrians may be detoured around work area, so please watch for sidewalk signage. In addition, the signal lights at the Maple St. and W. Broadway intersection will be disabled for about one week beginning on January 20. Traffic control personnel will be stationed at the intersection 24/7 to direct traffic at this time. People travelling in the area may experience traffic congestion. Some street parking has been removed, so check out parking alternatives. Posted speed limits have been reduced. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. The map below shows the work zone in orange and the access restrictions in red.
