





## Preparing to install the traffic deck at the future Oak-VGH Station begins on March 14 – Night Work

March 7, 2021

Note: The notice from Feb. 23, 2022 includes this work and we have updated scheduling, traffic details, and impacts to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood preparing to install the traffic deck in front of the Oak-VGH station block. Some work will be done overnight to minimize impacts to residents, businesses, and traffic. The work includes nighttime excavation, followed by the installation of supports and deck panels on W. Broadway, between Laurel and Oak streets. The traffic deck is expected to be completed in the summer.

## What to Expect

Access to residences, businesses, and parking lots will be maintained throughout the night work. People in the area can expect congestion, sidewalk modifications, overnight lane and turn restrictions on W. Broadway, including alternating one-way traffic at night during deck installation. Pedestrians may be detoured around the work. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Check out our Project video for more details on how we are building the traffic deck. Residents will experience elevated noise during the work. Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day and minimizing the use of back-up beepers. Laurel St. remains accessible to Emergency Vehicles only.
