





Rock-breaking upcoming in the Oak-VGH area



The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood beginning the next phase of excavation for the future Oak-VGH station building on the southwest corner of Laurel Street and W. Broadway. As part of this work, BSPC is excavating beneath the traffic deck in preparation for the construction of the underground station. Excavation is anticipated to be completed in Winter 2023.

As part of the excavation process, large pieces of rock may be uncovered and then broken apart in order to be removed. Residents and businesses in the area will experience loud noise and vibrations during the rock breaking activities. This activity will occur intermittently between the hours of 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. For full hours of operation at this worksite, refer to the hours of work notification.

Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

We know that construction is disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. We will continue to keep you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future to help you plan accordingly. Thank you in advance for your patience.
