





Arbutus Street restricted to local traffic only between W. Broadway and W. 10th Avenue starting July 8, 2022

July 7, 2022

Note: The notice from May 27, 2022 includes this work and we have updated scheduling, traffic details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building an at-grade, safe and consistent four-lane traffic deck. While most work is performed during the day, some night work will be required to minimize impacts on residents, businesses, and traffic.

Arbutus Street will be closed to all but local traffic between W. Broadway and W. 10th Avenue beginning Friday, July 8 at 8 p.m. until Monday, July 11 at 6 a.m. for paving and traffic deck panel installation on W. Broadway. In addition, left turns will not be permitted from W. Broadway onto Arbutus Street. Please use alternative routes from Burrard or MacDonald Street to access W. Broadway at this time.

During restricted access on Arbutus St., people in the area can expect traffic control personnel to be stationed at key junctions adjacent to the work area to manage traffic and allow local traffic only to access residences, businesses, and parking lots throughout the work.

We know that construction is disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. Residents can also expect sidewalk modifications, pedestrian detours and elevated noise during this work. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and follow instructions from traffic control personnel and all signs. Mitigation measures for noise include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day and installing white noise back-up beepers on heavy construction equipment during nighttime construction. Thank you in advance for your patience.
