Re: Broadway Subway Project Early Works – Utility Relocation near Cambie Street Segment A: W. 10th Avenue, between Cambie St. and Ash St.

Between December 2019 and March 2020, early construction work will be taking place in the Cambie Street and W. Broadway area to relocate TELUS infrastructure, in preparation for construction of the Broadway Subway Project. This work is anticipated to take place in the following segments:

- Segment A: W. 10th Ave., between Cambie St. and Ash St.
- Segment B: North on Ash St. to W. Broadway
- Segment C: North on Ash St., crossing W. Broadway
- Segment D: North on Ash. St., W. Broadway to W. 8th Ave.
- Segment E: East on W. 8th Ave. to Cambie St.
- Segment F: Intersection of W. 8th Ave. and Cambie St.
- Segment G: W. 10th Ave., crossing Cambie St.

Timing of this work is subject to change, and work in these segments may not necessarily be undertaken in sequence. The Broadway Subway Project is committed to keeping you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future so you can plan accordingly. Please note, construction schedules can change on short notice. Updates will be posted to the Project's website, emailed to local registered contacts, and additional notification will be provided where possible.

SEGMENT A: Beginning December 2, 2019, crews will be working on W. 10th Ave., west of Cambie St., and moving west towards Ash St. over the following weeks. This section of W. 10th will be open to local traffic only.



Anticipated general work area for Segment A. Crews will move west along W. 10th Ave. between Cambie St. and Ash St. Please note the work area depicted may not be exact, and the timing, location, and nature of work is subject to change.

Throughout December, W. 10th Avenue between Cambie St. and Ash St. will be open to local vehicle traffic only. Access for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained, as well as residential and business access.

Fred Thompson Contractors is completing this work under conditions outlined by a City of Vancouver permit.

The Broadway Subway Project is a 5.7 km extension of the Millennium Line, from VCC-Clark Station to Broadway and Arbutus, and is being funded and delivered by the Province of B.C. with contributions from the Government of Canada and the City of Vancouver. It includes six new underground stations, and will provide fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service to B.C.'s second-largest jobs centre, world-class health services, an emerging innovation and research hub, and growing residential neighbourhoods.
