## **Broadway Subway Project Early Works – Utility Relocation Near Cambie Street**

### **W. BROADWAY & CAMBIE STREET AREA – TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURES AND NOISE BY-LAW EXEMPTIONS**

Early pre-construction work is taking place in the Cambie Street and W. Broadway area through March 2020, to relocate TELUS infrastructure in preparation for construction of the Broadway Subway Project. The following is an update on anticipated upcoming work in this area.

To minimize disruption as much as possible, some work is being undertaken on weekends. While traffic will be maintained, we anticipate this work may cause temporary delays, restrictions to on-street parking, and noise impacts, and we apologize in advance for any disruption. #### **1. Crossing W. Broadway at Ash Street – Weekend of February 22-23, 2020**

On the weekend of February 22 and 23, it is anticipated that crews will begin crossing W. Broadway on Ash Street, resulting in temporary lane closures on Broadway. Work will be undertaken in stages to maintain two-way traffic flow and movement of buses. **The City of Vancouver has granted a noise by-law exemption permit for work on Sunday, February 23, 2020 from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM**

#### **2. Crossing Cambie Street at W. 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue – Weekends of March 7-8, 2020 and March 14-15, 2020**

On the weekends of March 7 to 8 and March 14 to 15, it is anticipated that crews will begin crossing Cambie Street on W. 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Work will be undertaken in stages to maintain two-way traffic and bus movements. **Updates will be made via the Project website for changes to timing, and work requiring a City of Vancouver noise by-law exemption (anticipated Sunday, March 8 and Sunday, March 15, 2020, 7:00 PM to 8:00 PM).**

#### **3. W. 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue at Cambie Street (east side of Cambie Street)**

Following the crossing of Cambie Street, crews will continue working on W. 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue just east of Cambie Street. It is anticipated that eastbound vehicle access on W. 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be restricted from Cambie Street while this work is underway. Access will be maintained for pedestrians and cyclists.

### **About the Broadway Subway Project**

The Broadway Subway Project is a 5.7 km extension of the Millennium Line, from VCC-Clark Station to Broadway and Arbutus. The Project is being funded and delivered by the Province of B.C. with contributions from the Government of Canada and the City of Vancouver. It includes six new underground stations, and will provide fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service to B.C.'s second-largest jobs centre, world-class health services, an emerging innovation and research hub, and growing residential neighbourhoods.
