Broadway Subway Project Early Works – Utility Relocation Near Cambie Street

TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURES ON CAMBIE STREET AND W. 10TH AVENUE

Early pre-construction work is taking place in the Cambie Street and W. Broadway area through March 2020, to relocate TELUS infrastructure in preparation for construction of the Broadway Subway Project.

The following is an update on anticipated upcoming work in this area.

To minimize disruption as much as possible, some work is being undertaken on weekends. While traffic will be maintained, we anticipate this work may cause temporary delays, restrictions to on-street parking, and noise impacts, and we apologize in advance for any disruption.

1. Crossing Cambie Street on W. 10th Avenue – Weekends of February 29, 2020 and March 7, 2020

On the weekends of February 29 and March 1, it is anticipated that crews will begin crossing Cambie Street on W. 10th Avenue. Work will be undertaken in stages to maintain two-way traffic and bus movements.

2. W. 10th Avenue at Cambie Street (east side of Cambie Street)

Following the crossing of Cambie Street, crews will continue working on W. 10th Avenue just east of Cambie Street. It is anticipated that eastbound vehicle access on W. 10th Avenue will be restricted from Cambie Street while this work is underway. Access will be maintained for pedestrians and cyclists.

Fred Thompson Contractors is completing this work for TELUS under conditions outlined by a City of Vancouver permit. Please refer to temporary directional signage and traffic control personnel on site.

The Broadway Subway Project is a 5.7 km extension of the Millennium Line, from VCC-Clark Station to Broadway and Arbutus. The Project is being funded and delivered by the Province of B.C. with contributions from the Government of Canada and the City of Vancouver. It includes six new underground stations, and will provide fast, frequent and convenient SkyTrain service to B.C.'s second-largest jobs centre, world-class health services, an emerging innovation and research hub, and growing residential neighbourhoods.
