UPDATE: Broadway Subway Project Trolley Overhead Wire Removal

Dear neighbour,

During the early planning phase of the Broadway Subway Project, the Province, TransLink and the City of Vancouver together identified the need to relocate trolley infrastructure off Broadway and implement detour routes during project construction. These bus detours will keep Broadway safe for workers and the public while keeping buses, people and traffic moving during construction.

This letter is to advise that sections of overhead trolley wires will be removed along Broadway at the following intersections near future subway stations: Main Street, Cambie Street, Oak Street, Granville Street and Arbutus Street.

Work at each location is expected to take between two and four days, primarily on weekends but with some preparatory work in advance of weekend work. This work will occur mainly during daytime hours, with the possibility of some overnight work on a case-by-case basis. There will be some noise and traffic-related effects such as temporary lane closures.

Work will occur between July 1 and September 30, 2020, depending on crew availability. As construction schedules are confirmed, information will be posted at https://engage.gov.bc.ca/broadwaysubway/whats-happening-now/.
