## **Broadway Subway Project Early Works BC Hydro Relocation – Arbutus Street**

As follow-up to the [previous notification letter](#) (April 21, 2020), we are writing to provide you with more information about upcoming work being undertaken by BC Hydro in the Arbutus and Broadway area, as part of early works to prepare for construction of the Broadway Subway Project.

This update relates to anticipated work during the week of May 11 and the week of May 18, 2020. Further information will be provided at subsequent stages of this work, which is anticipated to continue through July 2020. Updates will be posted to the Broadway Subway Project website:

### **Week of May 11, 2020**

- Work is anticipated to begin at W. 7<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Arbutus Street. During this time, a portion of W. 7<sup>th</sup> Ave. between the Arbutus Greenway and Arbutus Street will be closed to vehicle traffic.
- While access will be maintained for cyclists and pedestrians, the location of safe pedestrian and cycling zones may change, and users are asked to follow the direction of on-site signage and traffic control personnel.
- Arbutus Street between W. 4<sup>th</sup> Ave. and W. Broadway is expected to be open to local vehicle traffic only, with a temporary partial and full closure of Arbutus Street anticipated between W. 7<sup>th</sup> Ave. and W. 8<sup>th</sup> Ave. Please follow the direction of on-site signage for notice of temporary detours.

### **Week of May 18, 2020**

- Work is anticipated to continue on Arbutus Street between W. 8<sup>th</sup> Ave. and W. Broadway, with northbound lane closures on Arbutus Street.
- While access will be maintained for pedestrians, the location of safe pedestrian and cycling zones may change, and users are asked to follow the direction of on-site signage and traffic control personnel.
- Following this, work is expected to continue south of W. Broadway, between Broadway and 10<sup>th</sup> Ave.

Please note the anticipated timing of this work and associated impacts are subject to change, and we apologize for any inconvenience and disruption.

The Broadway Subway Project is committed to keeping you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future so you can plan accordingly. Please note, construction schedules can change on short notice. Updates will be posted to the Project's website, and additional notification will be provided where possible.
