

COMMUNITY NOTICE – AUGUST 26, 2019

Upcoming Archaeology Work Near Great Northern Way

Starting Monday, September 9, 2019, the Ministry of Transportation will be undertaking archaeology investigation work near Great Northern Way and the campus of the Emily Carr University of Art and Design.

This archaeology work is expected to take approximately one week, and is being undertaken to better understand sub-surface conditions prior to the start of construction of the Broadway Subway Project in 2020.



Archaeological investigations will involve small hand excavations, (approximately 0.5 m x 0.5 m) using tools including hand shovels and augers. All investigations will be supported by archaeology monitors from local First Nations. All soil removed will be replaced to leave the area intact.

We do not anticipate any traffic impacts related to this work. Noise will be minimal and will comply with relevant City of Vancouver noise bylaws.
