

Traffic Patterns are changing between Mount Pleasant and Broadway-City Hall as Major Construction Begins

May 20, 2021

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the traffic deck. Once completed, the traffic deck maintains an at-grade, safe and consistent four lane traffic configuration while construction continues below ground. Residents and businesses may experience some noise and vibration as the drilling of structural supports begin for the traffic deck. People travelling in the area should expect congestion, and reduced street parking, speed limits and travel lanes. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Check out our Project [video](#) for more details on how we are building the traffic deck.

What to Expect



Timing

- Drilling may begin as early as May 19
- Traffic pattern changes to begin as early as May 25
- Work expected to be completed in August

**Schedules can change without notice*



Hours of Work

- Day: 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Occasional Night: 6 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- When possible, crews will perform the noisiest construction activities during the day to minimize overnight noise.

** Work will primarily be completed Monday to Saturday but may on occasion occur Sunday.*



Traffic

- Three lanes of traffic will be maintained during this work: 2 eastbound and 1 westbound from Kingsway to Columbia St.
- Quebec St. will be closed from E. Broadway to the laneway towards 10th.
- Temporary traffic signals will replace existing signals.
- Flaggers and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Street parking along Broadway will be removed.
- Curb lanes will be dedicated for emergency vehicles and buses.
- Transit users can check the [Trip Planner](#) as some stop locations have changed.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses and services.
- Sidewalk segments may be closed and pedestrians detoured around work zones.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. Thank you in advance for your patience.
