

Traffic Alert - Central Valley Greenway Detour Opens

May 14, 2021

When – As early as Monday, May 17, 2021 until Fall 2025

- The Central Valley Greenway (CVG) multi-purpose path is being detoured to ensure the safety of the pedestrians and cyclists who use this route during construction of the Broadway Subway Project.
- At Great Northern Way, access from existing the CVG to the CVG branches near Emily Carr University and Thornton St. will be closed.
- The detour extends the CGV along the north side of East 2nd Ave., west of Brunswick St. and connects to E 1st. Ave via Scotia St.
- Drivers are asked to use extra caution when turning onto Scotia St. from East 2nd Ave. and East 1st Ave., as they will now be sharing the road with cyclists.
- Cyclists will be separated from vehicle traffic by concrete barriers.
- Cyclists are asked to use the new detour route, as Thornton St. is closed to both cycle and vehicle traffic.
