

Utility Relocation along Oak Street and West Broadway

June 14, 2021

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) will be in your neighbourhood relocating utilities ahead of construction. In preparation for the installation of a traffic deck this summer, the following works will be carried out near the future Oak-VGH Station in the intersection of Broadway and Oak Street and on Broadway between Oak Street and Laurel Street.

- Utility investigation
- Median removal
- Utility relocation

Starting as early as the week of June 14th crews will be working during the day, performing utility investigations, and examining the existing sanitary and storm lines before installing temporary lines. Once the existing utilities are removed, the temporary lines will be safely covered and paved over. People in the area may expect some noise, congestion, and reduced street parking. Please watch for wayfinding information and obey traffic control personnel and all signs



What to Expect



Timing

- Utility investigations starting as early as the week of June 14, 2021
- Median removal and utility relocation activities to follow, with a target completion date in August 2021



Hours of Work

- Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Utility relocation may include occasional night work: 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

**Some work may take place outside these hours as required.*



Traffic

- Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction on Broadway
- Middle lanes adjacent to the median will be closed during median removal
- Traffic may be reduced to one lane intermittently on Laurel Street and Oak Street during utility relocation
- Dynamic Messaging Signages to direct motorists will be in effect



Impacts/Interruptions

- On-street parking between Oak Street and Spruce Street will be unavailable intermittently
- On-street parking between Laurel Street and Oak Street will be removed
- Sidewalks and access to health services, businesses and residences will be maintained
- Crosswalks may be closed near work zones – please watch for signs and flaggers
- Noise from the hydro-vac excavation process for utility investigation and relocation
- The utility relocation will require a short-term water shut off. Impacted stakeholders will be contacted in advance of work being performed.

Updates will be provided at broadwaysubway.ca/construction, and the location of the work can be viewed on a map at: broadwaysubway.ca/construction/maps/. Updates will also be emailed to local registered contacts, and additional notification will be provided where possible. Please note, construction schedules can change on short notice.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. We will continue to keep you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future to help you plan accordingly. Thank you in advance for your patience.
