

## Traffic Alert - Traffic patterns are changing around Broadway-City Hall Station as major construction continues

July 9, 2021

- The traffic changes on Broadway from Alberta Street to Yukon Street will be extended west to Cambie Street overnight on Sunday, July 11 into Monday, July 12.
- Traffic between Cambie and Yukon streets will be reduced and shifted to the northside of Broadway to align with the three-lane configuration (2 eastbound and 1 westbound) between Yukon Street and Alberta Street.
- Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
- Once completed later this year, 4 at-grade lanes will be restored on Broadway, while construction continues below the traffic deck.
