

E. Broadway to be widened in Mount Pleasant. Notification of Night Work

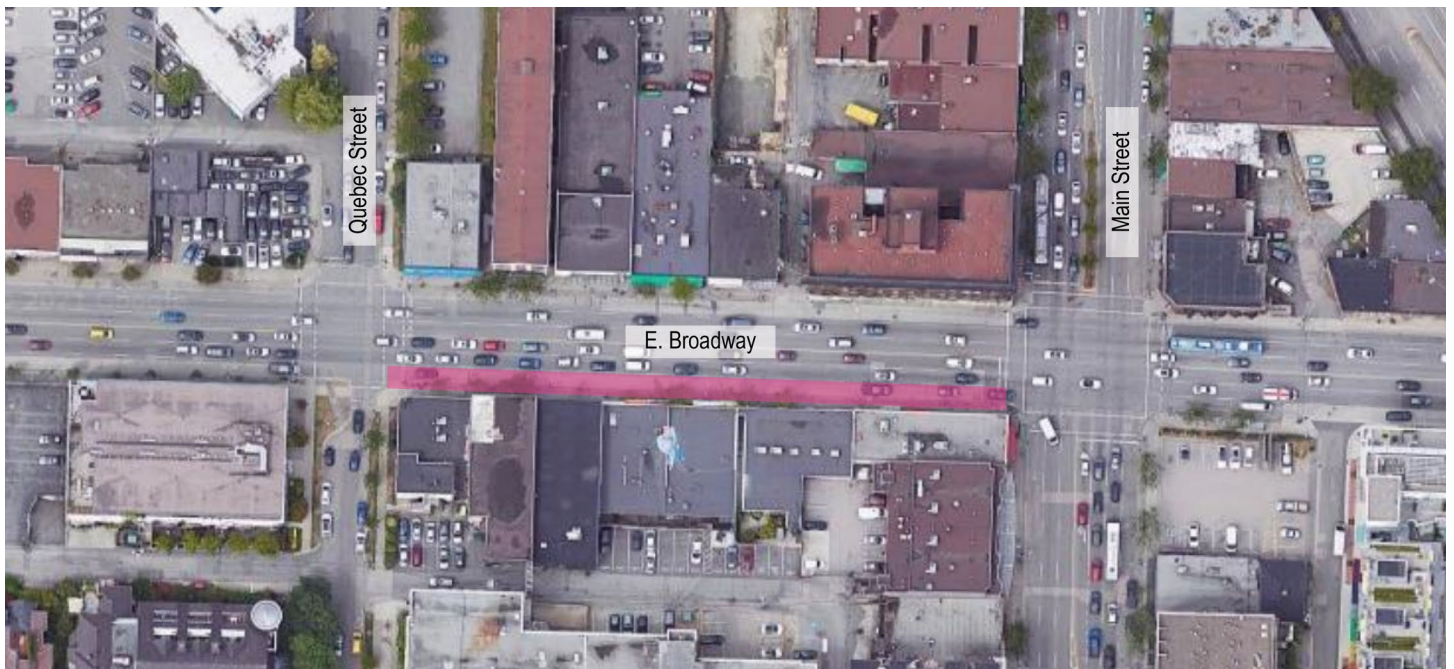

UPDATE: The notification dated July 26, 2021, has been updated with current scheduling details.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building an at-grade, safe and consistent four-lane traffic deck. As part of this work, BSPC will widen the roadway by about 60 cm on the southside of E. Broadway between Main and Quebec streets. The upcoming work also includes the relocation of streetlights on the south side of E. Broadway, narrowing of the south sidewalk, eradicating and painting new road lines, and shifting the traffic.

Residents and businesses may experience noise. People travelling in the area should expect congestion, and reduced street parking, speed limits and travel lanes. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Check out our Project [video](#) for more details on how we are building the traffic deck. The shaded area on map below illustrates the area of work.

What to Expect



Timing

- As early as July 28. Estimated duration: one week.
- Night work anticipated July 28, 29 and August 3.
- Construction of the traffic deck is anticipated to be completed in the fall.



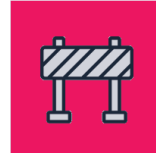
Hours of Work*

- Monday to Saturday
 - Night: 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - Day: 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- * *When possible, crews will perform the noisiest construction activities during the day to minimize overnight noise.*
- * *Work will primarily be completed Monday to Saturday but may on occasion occur Sunday.*



Traffic

- E. Broadway between Main and Quebec streets: Eastbound curb lane closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., reducing E. Broadway to two lanes (one in each direction).
- Turn restrictions in effect at the intersection of Main Street and E. Broadway.
- Quebec Street closed from E. Broadway to the lane south of E. Broadway.
- Flaggers and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Residents and businesses may experience noise.
- No parking on Broadway from Main Street to Cambie Street.
- Transit users can check the [Trip Planner](#) as some stop locations have changed.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.
- Sidewalks segments may be closed, and pedestrians detoured around work zones.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. Thank you in advance for your patience.
