

# CCTV surveys of sewers near the future South Granville Station

September 1, 2021

**UPDATE: The notification dated June 18, 2021, has been updated with current scheduling details and map location.**

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) will be in your neighbourhood to document the condition of the sanitary sewer and storm lines near the future South Granville Station with closed-circuit TV (CCTV) cameras. Work areas are identified in the map below and include, but are not limited to:

- Multiple locations on Hemlock Street between W 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue and W 10<sup>th</sup> avenues;
- (Completed) - Eastbound curb lane on W Broadway between Birch and Hemlock streets;
- (Completed) - Eastbound curb lane on W Broadway from Granville east to the lane;
- (Completed) - Westbound curb lane on W 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Hemlock and Granville streets; and
- (Completed) - Southbound Granville between W 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the south side of the intersection at W Broadway.

There are traffic impacts we want you to be aware of before you travel.

## What to Expect



### Timing

- As early as September 3, 2021 – Intersection of Hemlock Street at W 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue extending south toward the lane.



### Hours of Work

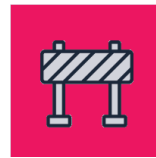
- 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays

*\*work may happen outside these hours if required*



### Traffic During Work

- There will be temporary lane closures lasting up to 60 minutes.
- W. 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue closed to through traffic at the intersection of Hemlock Street. Westbound traffic will be detoured north on Hemlock Street; eastbound traffic will be detoured south on Hemlock Street..
- Hemlock Street: single-lane traffic north-south through the intersection through the intersection at W 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- Traffic controllers will be used to direct traffic and assist pedestrians and cyclists.



### Impacts/Interruptions

- Access for businesses and residences will be maintained.
- Access to bus stops will be maintained.
- Street parking will be temporarily restricted on Hemlock Street during the CCTV investigation.
- Select crosswalks will be temporarily closed near CCTV investigation sites.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. We will continue to keep you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future to help you plan accordingly. Thank you in advance for your patience.
