

Relocating sewer beneath Cambie Street starts in September and continues into Spring 2022: Some Night Work

UPDATE: The notification dated [September 20, 2021](#), has been updated with current scheduling details.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood extending SkyTrain's Millennium Line. In preparation for building the new station at Broadway City-Hall, the sanitary and combined sewer lines running beneath Cambie Street will be relocated. This sewer relocation project will start in October and continue into Spring 2022.

Before we connect the new pipes to the existing sewer lines, we need to install bypass pipes to enable a seamless activation of the new sewer pipes. The installation of bypass pipes will be conducted over approximately four weeks at night to minimize traffic disruptions. Work includes, but is not limited to the following activities:

- Excavate and install sewer pipes across Cambie Street at W. 10th Avenue (**Night work**);
- Relocate TransLink trolley lines;
- Realign traffic signals on Cambie at Broadway (**Night work**);
- Remove the median on Broadway between W. 8th Avenue and W. 12th avenues; and
- Modify traffic lanes and shift traffic to the east side of Cambie between W. 8th and W. 12th avenues.

Once the bypass sewer pipes are installed, we will then begin excavating and installing the permanent sewer pipes on Cambie Street between W. 8th and W. 10th avenues. This stage of work will continue through the Spring.

Please note, this information is current at the time of sending, however due to unforeseen circumstances, schedules are subject to change.

What to Expect



Timing

- Starting October 2021 until Spring 2022



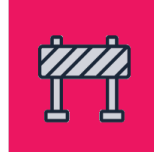
Hours of Work

- Day: 7 a.m. – 8 p.m.
- Night: 8 p.m. – 5 a.m.



Traffic

- During the installation of bypass sewer pipes, traffic on Cambie is reduced to three lanes between Broadway and W 12th Ave (2 southbound and 1 northbound) from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Left turns maintained at W. 10th Ave for northbound traffic.
- Flaggers and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Residents and businesses may experience elevated noise.
- Sidewalk segments may be closed, and pedestrians will be detoured around work zones.

Other important information:

- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses and services.
- Emergency access is maintained at all times.
- When possible, crews will perform the noisiest construction activities from 8-10 p.m. to reduce overnight noise.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. We will continue to keep you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future to help you plan accordingly. Thank you in advance for your patience.
