





# Northern intersection of W. Broadway at Yukon Street closed to vehicle traffic until late October

October 13, 2021

# The notification dated September 21, 2021, has been updated with current scheduling details.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building an at-grade, safe and consistent four-lane traffic deck. BSPC is currently drilling structural supports for the traffic deck on the north side of W. Broadway between Cambie and Alberta streets. There are also utilities to relocate on Yukon between W Broadway and W. 8th Avenue.

As the work progresses across Yukon Street, the northern half of the intersection will be closed to vehicle traffic for approximately three weeks with access maintained for cyclists and pedestrians. Yukon Street will also be closed to all but local vehicle traffic between W 8th Avenue and W. Broadway. Both closures are identified by the yellow boxes in the map below; the local- traffic-only area is identified in blue.

Please note, this information is current at the time of sending, however due to unforeseen circumstances, schedules are subject to change.













# What to Expect



## **Timing**

 Starting the night of September 22 and continuing until late October.



#### Hours of Work

 Traffic closure will be in effect 24 hours a day, seven days a week.



### **Traffic**

- The intersection on the north side of W. Broadway at Yukon Street is closed to vehicle traffic and remains open to cyclists and pedestrians.
- Flaggers and traffic signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate.



## Impacts/Interruptions

- Pedestrians may be detoured around work zones.
- Residents and businesses may experience some noise.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.

# Other important information:

- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses and services.
- Emergency access is maintained at all times.
- When possible, crews will perform the noisiest construction activities during the day to reduce overnight noise.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. We will continue to keep you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future to help you plan accordingly. Thank you in advance for your patience.
