

Removing trees on Cambie Street between W. 7th Avenue and Broadway starting October 18

October 12, 2021

The notification dated October 5, 2021, has been updated with current scheduling details.

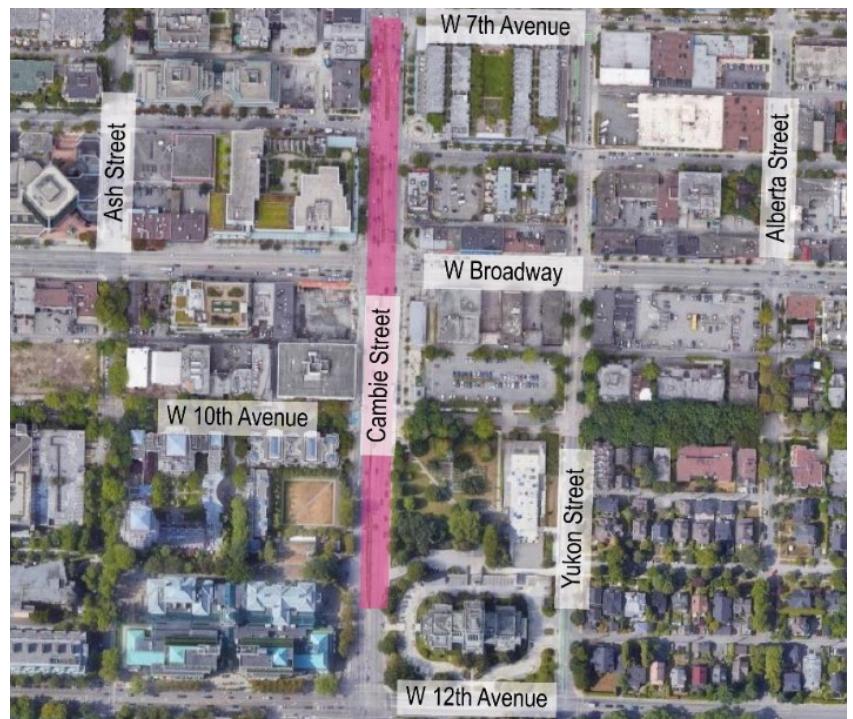
The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) will be removing five cherry trees in the centre median on Cambie Street between W. 7th Avenue and Broadway to allow for the safe relocation of sewer lines beneath Cambie Street. This removal process has included a review by Vancouver Park Board personnel.

The Project team will work with the City of Vancouver through the street design process to replace these trees with new trees that complement existing trees in this neighbourhood. In addition, the landscape team will create vegetation features to maintain the neighbourhood's distinct look and feel.

Trees will be removed concurrently with the median removal referenced in the [September 24](#) notification. The map below and details about what to expect are related to the full duration of the median removal.

What to Expect

- Work will continue throughout October
- Cambie Street between W. 7th and W. 12th avenues will be reduced to four lanes (two in either direction).
- Left turns lanes maintained for north and southbound traffic at W. 7th, W. 8th and W. 10th avenues.
- Residents and businesses may experience elevated noise.
- Parking will be restricted during construction hours on northbound Cambie between W. 12th and W. 10th avenues.
