

Traffic Alert – E. Broadway reduced to one lane in each direction during the off-peak period on October 22

October 20, 2021

- E. Broadway between Main and Quebec streets will be reduced to one lane in each direction for one hour between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Friday, October 22.
- Traffic will return to a three-lane configuration (2 eastbound and 1 westbound) by 3 p.m.
- Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
- The temporary closure supports the removal of equipment from the area being excavated for the traffic deck.
- Once completed later this year, 4 at-grade lanes will be restored on Broadway, while construction continues below the traffic deck.
