

## Traffic Alert – E. Broadway reduced to single-lane alternating traffic from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., October 12-16

October 8, 2021

- E. Broadway around the intersection of Quebec Street will be reduced to two lanes (one in each direction) at night from 8 to 10 p.m., followed by single-lane, alternating traffic from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., starting the evening of October 12.
- Regular traffic patterns resume at 5 a.m. each morning and work ends the morning of October 16.
- Traffic delays of up to 10 minutes might occur throughout the night.
- Traffic will return to a three-lane configuration (2 eastbound and 1 westbound) after 5 a.m.
- Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
- The temporary traffic configuration supports the relocation of the main water line below Broadway in Mount Pleasant to facilitate construction of the traffic deck.
- Once completed later this year, 4 at-grade lanes will be restored on Broadway, while construction continues below the traffic deck.
