

Implementation of Cambie Street traffic changes start Nov. 20

November 18, 2021

Note: The notice from Sept. 24, 2021 included this work and we now have an updated schedule to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood extending the Millennium Line. In preparation for building the new station at Broadway-City Hall, the sewer lines running beneath Cambie Street will be relocated. During this work, traffic will be reduced to four lanes and shifted to the east side of Cambie Street between W 7th and W 12th avenues.

Implementation of this traffic change starts Saturday, November 20 from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., and continues all day Sunday, November 21 until 5 a.m. on Monday, November 22. The work includes lane closures, relocation of trolley bus lines, line eradication, line painting, and relocating traffic signals.

Please note, this information is current at the time of sending; however, schedules are subject to change. Visit www.broadwaysubway.ca for current details.

What to Expect

People in the area can expect varying lane closures on Cambie Street on Saturday during the day and on Sunday morning. Cambie Street between W 7th and W 12th avenues will be reduced to one lane in each direction from 12 p.m. Sunday to 5 a.m. Monday. Residents will experience elevated noise on Sunday night. Mitigation measures include, but are not limited, conducting the noisiest construction activities in the day and early evening, and installing white noise back-up beepers on heavy construction equipment where possible. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
