

Night work at the Future Great Northern Way-Emily Carr Station – November 22 and 23

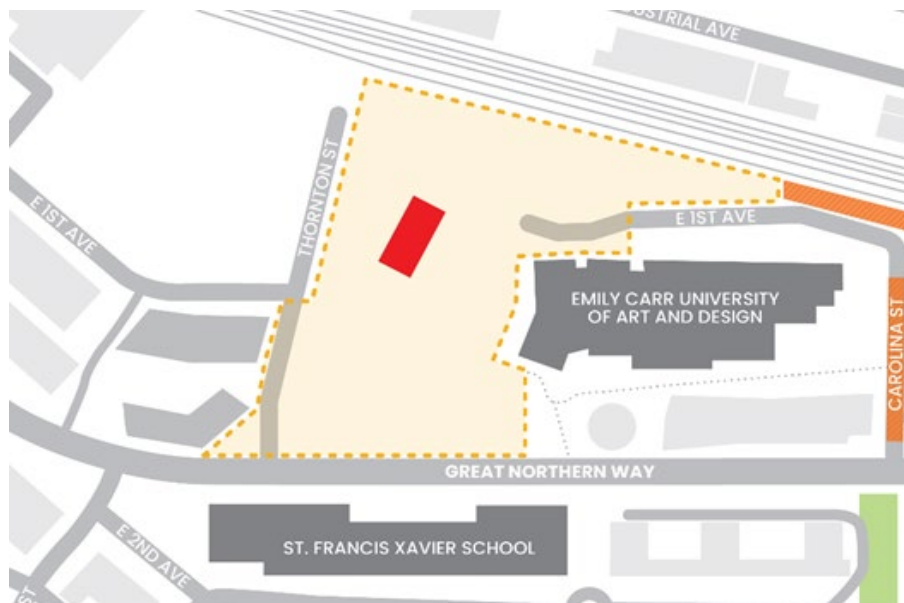
The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) will be in your neighbourhood relocating utilities ahead of construction of the Great Northern Way – Emily Carr Station. As part of this work, BSPC is preparing utilities in the area in advance of excavation. On Monday, November 22 and Tuesday, November 23 we will install steel supports that will be used to hang the utilities and keep them in place while BSPC excavates the area where the elevated guideway transitions below ground.

Residents and businesses in the area will experience elevated noise at night. Residents and businesses may also see a crane and temporary lighting on site. To mitigate expected elevated noise from 8 pm until 6 am the Project is:

- Conducting the noisiest part of the work is expected to happen on Monday night before 10 pm
- Utilizing a ‘whisper’ generator which emits a hum
- Minimizing the use of back-up-beepers

Please watch for wayfinding information and follow instructions from traffic control personnel and all signs. The work area is highlighted in red on map below.
