

Update: Installation of water main starts as relocating water lines connections continues near Broadway-City Hall

September 16, 2021

UPDATE: The notification dated September 7, 2021, has been updated with current scheduling details.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building an at-grade, safe and consistent four-lane traffic deck. As part of this work, BSPC has identified water lines and sanitary service connections to several properties on both sides W. Broadway between Cambie and Yukon streets that need to be relocated.

Upcoming work includes installing a new water main on the north side of W. Broadway from Cambie to Alberta. The water main will provide water to businesses and residences until the traffic decking is removed in 2024. Water to neighbouring businesses and residences may be temporarily shut off while properties are connected to the temporary water main. Water shutdowns will generally occur overnight to minimize the impact on businesses and residents.

BSPC will directly contact the businesses and residents we anticipate will be affected by a water shutdown or nightwork.

Please note, this information is current at the time of sending, however due to unforeseen circumstances, schedules are subject to change. BSPC will update this notification as specific dates and times for water shutdowns are confirmed.

What to Expect



Timing

- As early as Sept. 16 – Nightwork to relocate water connections to three commercial buildings on the northside of W. Broadway between Cambie and Yukon streets.
- As early as Sept. 20 - work on the temporary water main starts on the north side of W Broadway near Yukon Street, moving east.
- As early as Sept. 27 - work on the temporary water main starts on the north side of W Broadway near Cambie Street, moving east.




Hours of Work*

- Day: 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
 - Occasional Night: 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- * Most work will occur during the day; but water tie-ins and water shutdowns will generally happen at night.



Traffic

- Traffic on W. Broadway is reduced to three lanes between Yukon and Alberta Street during traffic deck construction (2 eastbound and 1 westbound), and four lanes west of Yukon (2 each direction).
- Flaggers and traffic signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Overnight water shutdown to select buildings starting at 11 p.m. Sept. 16 continuing to 2 a.m. on Sept. 17. Affected businesses will be directly notified.
- Residents and businesses may experience elevated noise.
- Sidewalk segments may be closed, and pedestrians detoured around work zones.

Other important information:

- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses and services.
- Emergency access is maintained at all times.
- When possible, crews will perform the noisiest construction activities during the day to reduce overnight noise.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. We will continue to keep you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future to help you plan accordingly. Thank you in advance for your patience.

Updates will also be emailed to local registered contacts, and additional notification will be provided where possible. Please note, construction schedules can change on short notice.
