

Utility relocations at Oak St. and W. Broadway begin Nov. 22 and temporary vehicle access restriction to Oak St. Nov. 29 – Night Work



Note: The notice from [November 12, 2021](#) included this work and we now have updated details to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is relocating storm and sanitary line connections in your neighbourhood starting Nov 22, ahead of major construction. Work at the intersection of Oak St. and W. Broadway, is being done overnight to minimize impacts to businesses, residents, and traffic. Part of this work will require a temporary restriction for vehicle access to Oak St. north of W. Broadway for about two weeks at night, beginning on Nov. 29. W. Broadway and Oak St. will be returned to regular, four-lane configurations each morning. The utility relocation work is expected to be completed by the end of the year. No utility shut-downs are expected from this work, if that changes, affected residents or businesses will be contacted directly.

What to Expect

Access to residences and businesses to be maintained throughout the night. During night work, two lanes of traffic will be maintained on W. Broadway and Oak St., one in each direction. This work will result in elevated noise at night. This work may also result in temporary right and left turn restrictions, and sidewalk detours. Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the evening and installing white noise back-up beepers on heavy construction equipment where possible. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Please note, this information is current at the time of sending; however, schedules are subject to change. Visit www.broadwaysubway.ca for current details.
