

Vehicle access to the north side Maple Street from W. Broadway will be temporarily restricted, starting on Monday November 8

November 4, 2021

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood relocating utilities ahead of major construction activities. To support repaving of the road following utility relocation, the north side of Maple St. at W. Broadway will be closed to vehicle traffic for up to three days, beginning on Monday November 8, while we complete paving works during our daytime working hours (Mon to Sat, 7 am to 8 pm, and Sun. 9 am to 8 pm). Temporary closures on Maple St. between the laneway towards W. 8th Ave. and W. Broadway may also be required. Vehicle and pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained. Pedestrians may be detoured around work area, so watch for sidewalk signage.

What to Expect

People travelling in the area may experience traffic congestion. Some street parking has been removed, so check out [parking alternatives](#), and posted speed limits may be reduced. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. The map below shows the Project work zones in yellow, the temporary access restrictions in red, and vehicle mobility with the black arrows.
