

Night Work to relocate utilities at Broadway between Maple and Arbutus streets begins on January 9, 2022

December 24, 2021

Note: The notice from [December 20, 2021](#) included this work and we now have current scheduling, traffic details, and impacts to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood relocating utilities from Arbutus to Maple St. ahead of major construction beginning on January 9. Due to the location of the utilities, this work is being done over night minimize impacts to businesses, pedestrians, and traffic. No water interruptions are anticipated. If that changes, BSCGP will directly contact property owners and businesses we anticipate would be affected. Work is expected to run until end of January 2022.

What to Expect

Access to residences, businesses, and parking lots will be maintained throughout the night work. While work to relocate the utilities will continue through the end of December until the end of January, work is not anticipated to occur during the upcoming holiday weekends. People in the area can expect overnight lane restrictions on W. Broadway, from Arbutus St. to Cypress St. and temporary sidewalk detours around the work area. Residents should also expect some activity in the project site area at Arbutus and Broadway. The work will result in elevated noise during the day and night. Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the early evening and minimizing the use of back-up beepers on heavy construction equipment during nighttime construction. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
