

Night Work to install the traffic deck in Mount Pleasant continues into mid-December

December 3, 2021

Note: The updated notice from November 29 included this work and we now have current times for completion of the traffic deck installation.

The installation of the traffic deck is ongoing on the north side of E. Broadway, having started from Main Street and moving west to Quebec Street. The installation of the north side of the traffic deck will continue into mid-December. This work involves placing support beams and deck plates at night and then bolting the traffic deck in place during the day. What to Expect

Daytime work starts at 7 a.m. with 2 eastbound and 1 westbound lanes of traffic on E. Broadway. During work overnight from 12 a.m. to 5 a.m., there is a single, alternating lane on E. Broadway between Quebec and Main streets with 10-minute lane closures for crane movements. As well, traffic on E. Broadway is reduced to one lane in each direction between Main and Quebec streets from 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. Monday-Saturday from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m on Sunday morning.

Residents and businesses will experience elevated noise and vibration, including bolt fastening sounds from impact drivers. Pedestrians will be detoured around work zones as required.

We also anticipate sidewalk modifications on Quebec Street north of E. Broadway. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Flaggers and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate.
