





Traffic deck installation starts in Mount Pleasant in October



Note: This is an update of the <u>October 18 notification</u> with and updated timeline for completion of the traffic deck installation.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building an at-grade, safe and consistent four-lane traffic deck. Installation of the traffic deck continues on the north side of E. Broadway, starting from Main Street and moving west towards Quebec Street. This work involves placing support beams and deck plates at night and then bolting the traffic deck in place during the day. Once work on the northside is complete, traffic will shift to the north and traffic deck installation work will continue on the south side of E. Broadway. Work is expected to be completed by early 2022.

Residents and businesses may experience some noise and vibration during the installation and bolting of the traffic deck. People in the area should expect congestion, possible temporary lane closures, and reduced street parking, speed limits and travel lanes. We also anticipate sidewalk modifications on Quebec Street at E. Broadway. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. What to Expect



Timing

November 2021 until early 2022



Hours of Work*

- Monday to Saturday
 - o Day: 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.
 - O Night work: 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - May include occasional work on Sunday.
- * Work will primarily be completed Monday to Saturday but may on occasion occur Sunday.



Traffic

- Between Quebec and Main streets, from 12:00 a.m. to
 5 a.m.: single, alternating lanes
- 10 minute lane closures for crane movements, expected once an hour starting at 12:00 a.m.
- In off-peak times, traffic on E.
 Broadway will be maintained (2 eastbound and 1 westbound)
- From 10 a.m. 3 p.m. Monday-Saturday into December there will be two lanes of traffic, one in each direction between Main and Quebec streets
- The intersection on the north and south sides of E. Broadway at Quebec Street remains closed to vehicle traffic, and open to pedestrians and cyclists.
- Turn restrictions in effect at the intersections of Main Street and E. Broadway; and and at Quebec Street and E. Broadway.
- Flaggers and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Residents and businesses may experience elevated noise and vibration.
- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.
- No street parking on Broadway from Main Street to Cambie Street.
- Pedestrians will be detoured around work zones as required.
- Transit users can check the <u>Trip Planner</u> as some stop locations have changed.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. Thank you in advance for your patience.
