

Update: Southern intersection of Yukon Street closing temporarily to vehicle traffic while utilities beneath W. Broadway are relocated

January 17, 2022

UPDATE: The notification dated [December 13, 2021](#), has been updated with current scheduling details.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the Broadway Subway Project. In preparation for building the traffic deck at Broadway-City Hall, the combined sewer lines running beneath Broadway will be relocated. To facilitate this work, the southern intersection of Yukon Street at W. Broadway will be closed to vehicle traffic later this January while access for cyclists and pedestrians is maintained. The northern intersection of Yukon Street at W. Broadway is already closed to vehicle traffic. The dark orange area in the map below illustrates the anticipated work zone.

Please note, this information is current at the time of sending, however, schedules are subject to change.

What to Expect



Timing

- Starting late January and continuing into February.



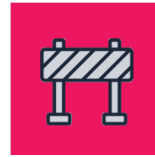
Hours of Work

- Monday to Saturday: 7 a.m. – 8 p.m.
- Sunday: 9 a.m. – 8 p.m.
- Occasional night work may be required



Traffic

- Traffic on W Broadway maintained as four lanes between Cambie and Yukon streets (2 lanes in each direction).
- During the installation of sewer pipes through the intersection of W. Broadway at Yukon Street, the south side of the intersection will be closed to vehicle traffic and maintained for cyclists and pedestrians.
- Flaggers and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Residents and businesses will experience elevated noise.
- Sidewalk segments will be closed, and pedestrians will be detoured around work zones.

Other important information:

- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses and services.
- Emergency access is maintained at all times.
- When possible, crews will perform the noisiest construction activities from 8-10 p.m. to reduce overnight noise.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. We will continue to keep you informed in advance of any local work now and in the future to help you plan accordingly. Thank you in advance for your patience.

Updates will also be emailed to local registered contacts, and additional notification will be provided where possible. Please note, construction schedules can change on short notice.
