

Daytime rock removal at Great Northern Way starts February 18

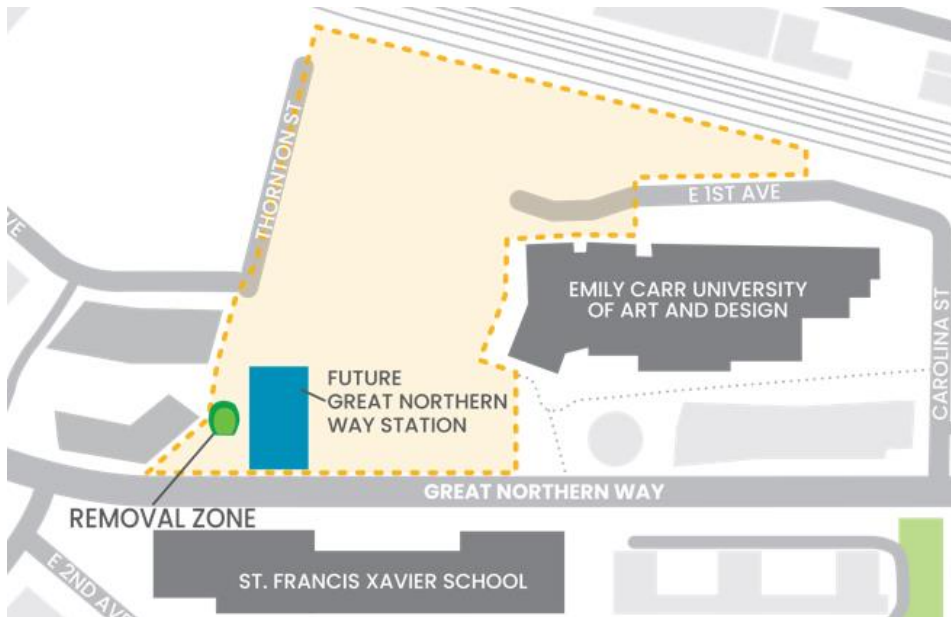
The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood preparing for tunnelling operations at the future Great Northern Way station. During excavation work, BSPC will be using controlled detonations to fracture bedrock before clearing materials from the site. This work is anticipated to continue until the end of March between 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

What to Expect

Rock is being removed between nine to twelve metres below the road surface within the project site area. Each detonation location will be covered in rubber matting to contain debris, air emissions, and sound impacts. During this work, people can expect to hear a pre-detonation warning marked with a series of twelve horn soundings and then a low frequency 'thud'. Once the activity is complete, there will be one long horn sound to indicate a return to regular work.

Pedestrians will be detoured around work zones as required. We also anticipate that the sidewalk on the north side of Great Northern Way between Carolina and Thornton streets, will be temporarily closed during each detonation. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Flaggers will assist pedestrians and cyclists around the site. Seismographic devices will be on site to assist our crews in monitoring all detonations.
