

Night Work to install the final section of the traffic deck in Mount Pleasant starts February 18

February 17, 2022

Note: The updated notice from November 29, 2021 included this work and we now have updated details to share.

Installation of the remaining sections of the Mount Pleasant traffic deck continues during the day, as night work begins on February 18 to place support beams and deck plates along E. Broadway from Main Street towards Quebec Street. The traffic deck will be completed in mid-March. Want to learn more? Check out our [infographic](#) on how a traffic deck is built.

What to Expect

Three lanes of traffic will be maintained during all peak hours, seven days a week in Mount Pleasant. Starting February 18, traffic in this area will be reduced to a single, alternating lane between 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. These arrangements will be in place until the traffic deck is completed later in March. Once the traffic deck is completed, traffic will return to a four-lane configuration all day.

Residents and businesses will experience elevated noise and vibration. We also anticipate sidewalk modifications on Quebec Street south of E. Broadway. Pedestrians will be detoured around work zones as required. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Flaggers and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists to navigate.
