

Temporary lane closures on Main Street start February 22

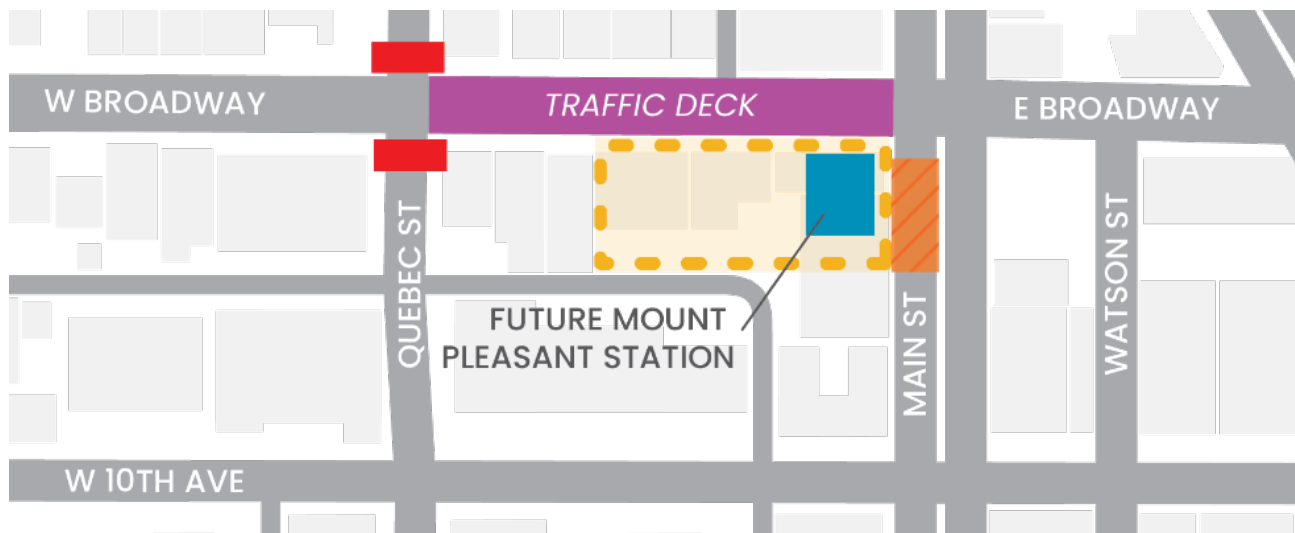

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood installing the traffic deck. As part of this work, BSPC will be relocating a catch basin and storm sewer on Main Street south of East Broadway. Work will start on February 22 and is expected to be completed in about two weeks.

Please note, this information is current at the time of sending; however, schedules are subject to change. BSPC will update the website with specific dates once timelines are confirmed. Visit www.broadwaysubway.ca for current details.

What to Expect

Two lanes will be maintained in the direction of peak traffic flow during morning and afternoon rushes Monday-Friday. Motorists travelling on Main Street between E. 8th and E. 10th avenues will experience temporary lane closures and parking restrictions from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Residents and businesses will experience elevated noise and vibration from some construction activities. Pedestrians will be detoured around work zones as required. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. There may be occasional work on Saturday and Sunday. The orange area in the map below indicates the work zone related to the storm sewer and catch basin relocation, while the red illustrates restricted vehicle access.
