

Arbutus Watermain Relocation – Some Night Work

March 14, 2022

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is relocating a watermain in your neighbourhood ahead of building the Arbutus Station. Work to relocate this utility will take place on Arbutus St. between W. 8th Ave. and W. 10th Ave. Work will begin south of W. Broadway before moving to the north of W. Broadway on Arbutus St. While most work will be performed during the day, periodic night work will be required to minimize impacts on residents, businesses, and traffic. This work is expected to be completed by December 2022.

Neighbours can expect elevated noise, lane closures, sidewalk modifications, and pedestrian detours on Arbutus St. and on W. Broadway. Mitigation measures for noise include, but are not limited to, conducting the noisiest construction activities during the day and installing white noise back-up beepers on heavy construction equipment during nighttime construction. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and follow instructions from traffic control personnel and all signs.

A water shut off will also be required, and **BSPC will directly contact the businesses and residents we anticipate will be affected by a water shutdown. Specific notification will also be given in advance for activities that are performed overnight.**

Please note, this information is current at the time of sending, however due to unforeseen circumstances, schedules are subject to change.

Timing

- March through December 2022



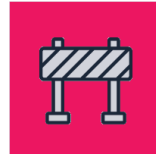
Hours of Work*

- Mon. to Sat., 6:00 am to 10:00 pm;
Occasional Sunday work
- Occasional overnight work



Traffic

- There will be temporary traffic restrictions northbound on Arbutus St. (8th Ave. to 10th Ave.) and along W. Broadway during the utility relocation.
- Traffic safety measures include signage and flaggers to manage traffic and assist pedestrians as needed.
- Temporary nighttime access restriction to Arbutus St. may be required.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Expect elevated noise.
- Pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained.
- People travelling or living in the area may notice increased construction vehicles.
- Transit users are asked to check TransLink's [Trip Planner](#) for a updated stop locations ahead of their trip, as some bus stops may be relocated during this work.
