

Traffic patterns are changing around Broadway-City Hall Station as traffic deck nears completion – Night Work

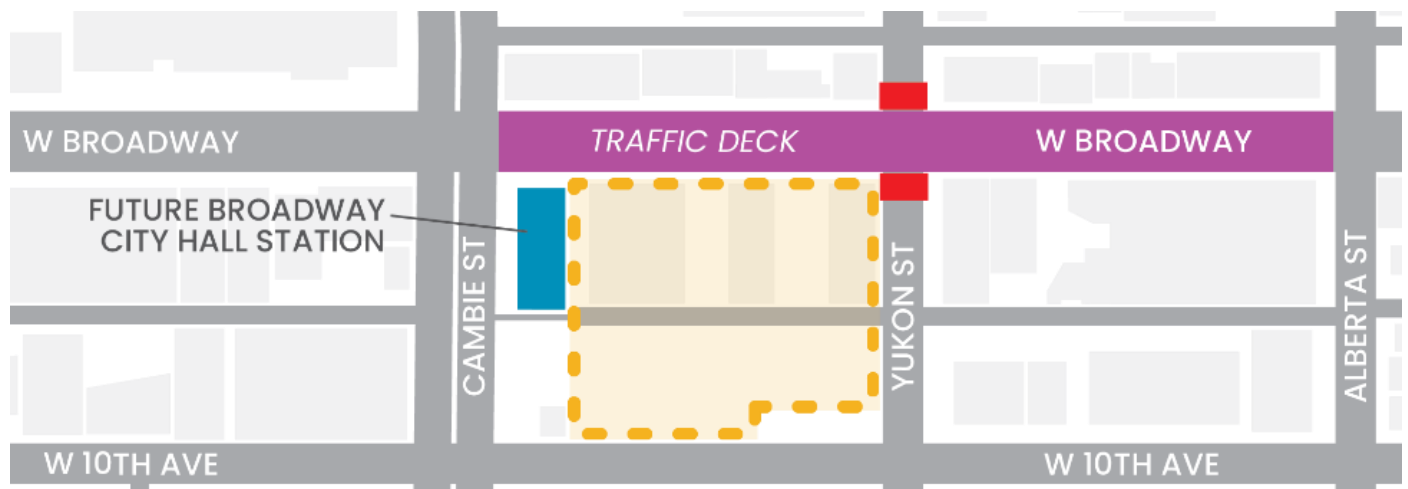

Note: The updated notice from February 2 included this work and we now have current night activities to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building a traffic deck in front of the future station at Broadway-City Hall between Alberta and Cambie streets. On the night of April 2, traffic will shift to drive on the completed traffic deck on the north side of W. Broadway between Alberta and Cambie streets. Thereafter, construction will commence on the south side of W. Broadway to build the remaining segment of the traffic deck. The full traffic deck is anticipated to be completed in early June 2022.

To prepare for the traffic shift, work will occur overnight on April 2 to 3, from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. During night work, a single lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained between Alberta and Cambie streets. One westbound and two eastbound lanes will be maintained during the day. People travelling in the area may experience some traffic congestion. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.

Flagger and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate. Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services. Sidewalk segments may be closed, and pedestrians detoured around work zones. When possible, crews will perform the noisiest construction activities during the day to minimize overnight noise. Please note, this information is current at the time of sending, however due to unforeseen circumstances, schedules are subject to change. Visit www.broadwaysubway.ca for current details.
