

Longer hours of work at the future Broadway-City Hall Station

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is working hard to complete major construction activities as we build the Broadway Subway Project. Our core working hours are changing to start as early as 5:30 a.m. and continue until the morning hours of 1 a.m., including arrival and departure of crews. Please note the Project also has the ability to work 24/7 and we will provide further notifications in advance of specific activities. Current overnight work involves utility service connections and installation of the traffic deck girders and panels.

What to Expect

Residents and businesses in the area should expect elevated noise, sidewalk modifications, temporary lane closures, reduced street parking and lower speed limits. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. Access to residences, businesses and parking garages will continue to be maintained during all work activities.

To help mitigate noise from construction, the Project:

- Conducts the noisiest part of the work during the daytime;
- Has built sound barriers along many Project areas;
- Minimizes the need for backing-up and installs white-noise back-up-beepers on major equipment.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood. We will continue to keep you informed in advance of work to help you plan accordingly, and updates on all construction activities are provided at broadwaysubway.ca/construction.
