

Update: Restricted vehicle access to the south side of Maple Street from W. Broadway will continue until Summer 2022

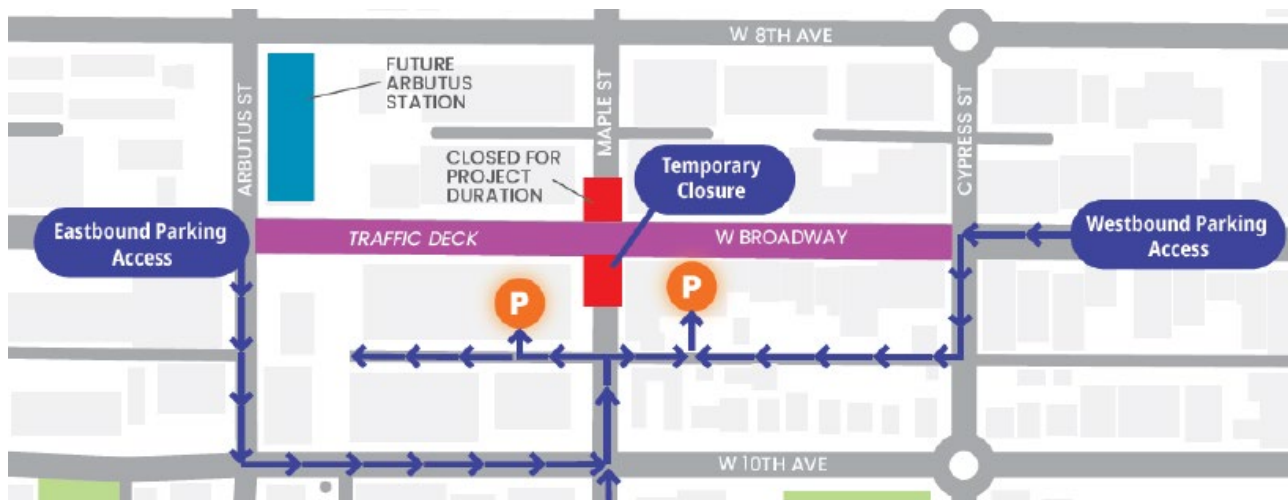
Note: The notice from Jan. 18, 2022 includes this work and we have updated scheduling, traffic details, and impacts to share.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood relocating utilities and building the traffic deck on W. Broadway. Vehicle access to the south side of Maple St. from W. Broadway will continue to be restricted while we build the traffic deck. Access will be re-instated in Summer 2022, once the south side traffic deck is complete.

What to Expect

While access to the south side of Maple St. is restricted, left turns at Cypress St. will be allowed from W. Broadway, westbound. Road access to Maple St. from 10th Ave to the laneway, parking garages, residences, and businesses will be maintained ([see alternative access map for details](#)). Pedestrians may be detoured around work area, so please watch for sidewalk signage. People travelling in the area may experience traffic congestion. Some street parking has been removed, so check out [parking alternatives](#). Posted speed limits have been reduced. Some turn restrictions may be maintained after access is re-instated. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. The map below shows access restrictions in red and alternative access routes.

Please note, this information is current at the time of sending; however, schedules are subject to change. BSPC will update the website with specific dates if timelines evolve. Visit www.broadwaysubway.ca for current details.
