

Yukon Street south of W. Broadway is temporarily closed to vehicle traffic

April 19, 2022

Update: The notification dated [January 19, 2022](#) has been updated with current scheduling details.

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building the Broadway Subway Project. In preparation for building the traffic deck at Broadway-City Hall, the combined sewer lines running beneath Broadway will be relocated. To facilitate this work, the southern intersection of Yukon Street at W. Broadway will be temporarily closed to vehicle traffic through the end of June. Access for cyclists and pedestrians is maintained. The dark orange area in the map below illustrates the anticipated work zone.

Please note, this information is current at the time of sending; however, schedules are subject to change. Visit www.broadwaysubway.ca for current details.

What to Expect

Yukon Street will be closed to vehicle traffic south of W. Broadway to the lane, pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured around the work zone. Residents will experience elevated noise during the work. Mitigation measures include, but are not limited to, installing white noise back-up beepers on heavy construction equipment where possible. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs.
