





Traffic deck installation at the future Arbutus station starts in May – Some Night Work

April 12, 2022

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood building an at-grade, safe and consistent four-lane traffic deck. This work will involve placing support beams and deck plates at night and then bolting the traffic deck in place during the day. Work will begin on the south side and is expected to shift to the north side of W. Broadway this summer. The traffic deck will be completed in the fall of 2022.

Residents and businesses will experience some noise and vibration during the installation and bolting of the traffic deck. People in the area should expect an increase of heavy machinery, congestion, temporary lane shifts and closures, and reduced speed limits and travel lanes. We also anticipate sidewalk and crosswalk modifications on Arbutus St. at W. Broadway. Please plan extra time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. What to Expect



Timing

May to Fall 2022



Hours of Work

- Monday to Saturday
 - o Day: 6 a.m. to 10 p.m.
 - Overnight: 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- May include occasional work on Sunday.



Traffic

- Current traffic configuration will be maintained during peak-times along W. Broadway.
- Turn restrictions in effect at the intersections of Arbutus and Cypress streets and W. Broadway.
- Single, alternating lanes between Cypress and Arbutus streets, from 11:00 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- 10-minute full road closures for crane movements, expected once an hour starting at 12:00 a.m. until 5:00 am
- Vehicle access to the south side of Maple St. from W. Broadway will be restricted while deck placement work takes place.
- Access to the north side of Maple St. is also restricted until project completion in 2025.



Impacts/Interruptions

- Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services.
- Elevated noise and vibration.
- Pedestrians will be detoured around work zones as required.
- Flaggers and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate.
- <u>View</u> the parking alternatives map for options.
- Transit users can check the <u>Trip Planner</u> as some stop locations have changed.

We know that construction can be disruptive, and we are working hard to minimize impacts in your neighbourhood and on your property. Thank you in advance for your patience.
