

Traffic patterns are changing around the future Mount Pleasant Station with completion of the traffic deck – Night Work

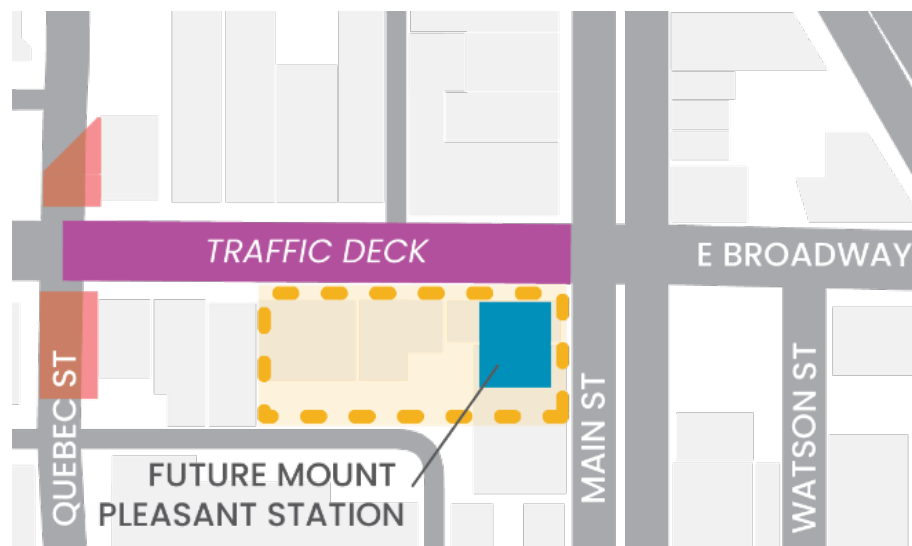

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood completing the traffic deck between Main and Quebec streets next week for the future station in Mount Pleasant. On the night of April 19, the traffic deck will be completed, and four lanes of traffic will be opened on E. Broadway between Main and Quebec streets to prepare for the traffic shift, work will occur overnight on April 19, from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Throughout this work, one lane westbound and one lane eastbound will be maintained between Main to Quebec streets. On the morning of April 20, the traffic deck will have four lanes (2 westbound, 2 eastbound).

What to Expect

Access for all abilities will be maintained to residences, businesses, and services. Sidewalk segments may be closed, and pedestrians detoured around work zones. Traffic control personnel and signs will assist pedestrians and cyclists navigate. We know that construction of the traffic deck has been disruptive, and appreciate your patience while we complete the first of five traffic decks along the Broadway Corridor.
