


Temporary trucking route and pedestrian detours around the future Arbutus Station in effect May 9

May 5, 2022

The Broadway Subway Project Corporation (BSPC) is in your neighbourhood preparing for the installation of the traffic deck between Arbutus and Cypress streets. During the remainder of surface excavation until the placement of traffic deck panels, the trucking route is temporarily changing. The route is shown in blue arrows in the map below, while the pedestrian detour is shown using the yellow solid line. Throughout construction activities, access to residences, businesses, and parking lots will be maintained. Here is how to navigate the local roads during this work:

- The temporary trucking route will be one-way, westbound, through the laneway between W. Broadway and 10th Ave. from Cypress St. to Arbutus St. While the route is in place, the lane will be one-way, westbound only for all vehicles.
- Cypress St. will be one-way only for project trucks, but bidirectional for other vehicles. Left turns onto Cypress St. from W. Broadway will be maintained. Cyclists can continue to use the protected cycling path in both directions.
- Maple St. continues to have restricted access between the laneway to W. Broadway until traffic deck completion.
- The laneway between the greenway and Arbutus St. will be opened to all vehicle traffic to ease congestion during the detour.

We thank residents, commuters, and businesses for their patience while we conduct the necessary work. People travelling in the area may experience some traffic congestion, periodic lane restrictions, sidewalk modifications and pedestrian detours around the work areas. Please plan extra travel time, watch for wayfinding information, and obey traffic control personnel and all signs. *Please note, this information is current at the time of sending; however, schedules are subject to change.
